**TITLE:** Entitlement to Registration Policy

**BOARD: RADIOGRAPHERS BOARD OF THE NORTHERN TERRITORY**

### **Purpose**

This policy has been developed to provide clear direction to staff of the Health Professions Licensing Authority, members of the Radiographers Board of the Northern Territory and intending registrants regarding the entitlement to register as a radiographer in the Northern Territory.

### **Supporting policies**

#### **Who is entitled to register as a radiographer in the Northern Territory?**

The Board will grant registration to radiographers who are able to provide evidence with their application as follows:

#### **Section 12 Are eligible to apply**

##### Radiographers educated in Australia or New Zealand

1. Certified copy of qualification from an Australian or New Zealand university;
2. Statement of Accreditation from the Australian Institute of Radiography;
3. Registration Certificate and current practising certificate;
4. Certified copies of proof of identity (Drivers Licence, Passport, Birth Certificate, Government issued identification);
5. Evidence of name change (eg; Marriage Certificate, Divorce Decree or Deed Poll)
6. A reference from the last place of employment
7. A recent character reference written in the last 6 months
8. Certificate of Good Standing from current or last place or registration / licensure
9. Declare that they have not had their name suspended or removed from a register or been refused registration for any reason relating to their professional conduct;
10. Declare that they have never been prohibited from or had any special condition imposed on their practise as a result of criminal, civil or disciplinary proceedings;
11. Declare that they have not been charged or convicted of any offence;
12. Declare that they do not suffer any physical or mental illness that would prevent them from practising competently; and
13. Declare that they are not currently practising in the Northern Territory.

##### Radiographers educated in overseas countries other than New Zealand

1. Statement of accreditation from the Australian Institute of Radiography, and
2. Points 3 to 13 as above.

##### New Graduates

New graduates are also required to provide a letter from their University attesting to their good character.
