**NORTHERN TERRITORY PENSIONER CONCESSION SCHEME
REIMBURSEMENT FOR TRAVEL CONCESSIONS FOR NON MEMBERS**

Reimbursement for travel concession will be calculated as followed:

Travel from interstate

The concession will be either 50% or 100% of a full economy airfare or the cost of the actual airfare whichever is the lesser amount.

Travel from overseas

The concession will be either 50% or 100% of the full economy airfare from either Darwin or Alice Springs to Adelaide, excluding taxes and GST or the cost of the actual airfare, whichever is the lesser amount.

Travel by private vehicle

The concession will be either 50% or 100% of the full economy airfare from either Darwin or Alice Springs to Adelaide, excluding taxes and GST or the cost of the actual airfare, whichever is the lesser amount.

Interstate Travel

There are two (2) options available as follows:-

- Reimbursement can be processed whilst you are still in the Northern Territory, by presenting your flight itinerary with your place of origin listed as your return destination, accompanied by a paid in full receipt, to the nearest community care centre or Family and Children's Services office.

Please note - Reimbursement will not occur if a return designation is not listed.

Or

- Upon return to your place of origin you must mail the used boarding passes, itinerary and receipts to the NT Pensioner Concession Unit at the below address for reimbursement.

Overseas Travel

There are two (2) options available as follows:-

- Reimbursement can be processed whilst you are still in the Northern Territory, by presenting your flight itinerary with your place of origin listed as your return destination, accompanied by a paid in full receipt, to the nearest community care centre or Family and Children's Services office. Payment of the concession amount will be reimbursed to the member, who will then forward the concession amount to the person traveling.

Please note - Reimbursement will not occur if a return designation is not listed.

Or

- The reimbursement for travel paid through an overseas agent will be reimbursed to the member of the Scheme, who will then forward the concession amount to the person traveling. Proof of purchase of the air tickets must be provided to the Pensioner Concession Scheme for payment to occur.

Private Vehicle Travel

- Upon return to your place of origin you must get the Private Vehicle travel form signed and stamped by a Police Officer or Australia Post Officer. When form is completed, mail it to the NT Pensioner Concession Unit at the below address for reimbursement.
