

## **Standards for Pharmacy Business and Services**

*Pursuant to Clause 4, Schedule 8, of the Health Practitioners Act*

### **DISPLAY OF NAMES**

A notice stating the name of the pharmacy (as registered) and the name(s) of the owner(s), is to be displayed at or near the main entrance of the pharmacy.

Adjacent to the area where dispensing is carried out, the name of the pharmacist-in-charge of the Pharmacy business followed by the words “Pharmacist-in-Charge” is to be displayed. The Board requires the display of the pharmacist-in-charge to be clearly visible to, and easily read by members of the public, and the name displayed must be that of the pharmacist who is in charge at the given time, and who is physically present in the pharmacy.
