The intention is to provide individuals an opportunity to report incidents to a neutral party, and also to collect details of incidents relating to drugs prone to abuse or diversion (ie Schedule 8s, benzodiazepines, anabolic steroids, pain killers etc).

Incidents which need to be reported include S8 register discrepancies, discrepancies in contract client medication, incorrect supply by wholesalers, theft by staff, break-ins, forgeries, and dispensing and prescribing errors for S8s.

The form may also be used by health care professionals when inspecting other facilities
