- (a) dated 12 October 2003 and published in *Gazette* No. G43 of 29 October 2003 at pages 2 to 4 of that *Gazette* (ref: 5/43);
- (b) the amendment to that approval dated 10 May 2004 and published in *Gazette* No. G19 of 12 May 2004 at page 4 of that *Gazette* (ref: 12/19); and
- (c) the amendment to that approval dated 14 October 2004 and published in *Gazette* No. G44 of 3 November 2004 at page 4 of that *Gazette* (ref: 11/44).

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**Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act****APPROVAL TO POSSESS AND SUPPLY SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES**

I, BARBARA ANN PATERSON, the Chief Health Officer, for the purposes of section 29(4A) of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and with reference to section 42 of the *Interpretation Act*, approve each registered nurse within the meaning of the *Health Practitioners Act* who is employed to perform duties:

- (a) at or from a health centre that is specified in Appendix A;
- (b) at or from a health service premises specified in Appendix B;

to possess and supply a substance listed in Schedule 2, 3, 4, or 8 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* in the course of his or her duties, subject to the following conditions:

- (c) a substance specified in Appendix C is to be supplied only in accordance with the intended use for the substance indicated in Column 2 of the Appendix;
- (d) a substance specified in Appendix D is to be supplied only in accordance with the intended use for the substance indicated in Column 2 of the Appendix;
- (e) a substance specified in Appendix D may be administered without the personal attendance or advice of a medical practitioner only if the nurse is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the medical condition of the person requires its administration without delay;
- (f) if a substance specified in Appendix D is administered in accordance with paragraph (e), the nurse who administered the substance must notify a medical practitioner of the matter as soon as practicable; and
- (g) a substance that is listed in Schedule 2, 3, 4, or 8 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and is not specified in Appendix C or D is only to be supplied

under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner, optometrist or a dentist.

- (a) a substance specified in Appendix B is to be supplied only in accordance with the intended use for the

- substance indicated in Column 2 of the Appendix; and
- (b) a substance that is listed in Schedule 2, 3, or 4 to the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act* and is not specified in Appendix B is only to be supplied under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner or a dentist.
