

**NORTHERN TERRITORY OF AUSTRALIA**

*Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act*

**DETAILS TO BE RECORDED**

I, STEVEN JAYE SKOV the Chief Health Officer, pursuant to section 28(1)(b) of the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act*, require that from 1 April 2008 a pharmacist or person under the direct supervision of a pharmacist must record the following details in an electronic on-line database, paper based database or electronic register for each retail supply of pseudoephedrine in Schedule 3 of the Standard for the Uniform Scheduling of Drugs and Poisons:

- a) the date of supply,
- b) the name of the purchaser,
- c) the address of the purchaser,
- d) the product name and unit quantity in pack supplied,
- e) the number of packs supplied, and
- f) a unique identification number for the purchaser from:
  - (i) a photographic identification document, or
  - (ii) if the purchaser can not produce a photographic identification document, a non-photographic identification document issued by a government agency,
- g) the type of identification produced by the purchaser.

The records must be available for inspection by an inspector under the *Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act*.
